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## Eligibility and Requirements

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- This Festival is juried. All artwork exhibited must be original artwork created and hand-produced by the artist. The main criteria for acceptance will be the quality and uniqueness of your work, along with the category/medium needs of the Festival.
- This Festival is for artists and craftpersons only. No applications will be accepted from commercial dealers, agents, manufacturers or representatives.
- Reproductions of artwork are permitted if processed by the artist or under the artist's supervision. Reproductions must be clearly labeled with a description of the process and materials used.
- Kit-produced items, manufactured objects and work that is not personally made by the exhibiting artist are unacceptable.
- Artists agree to be present for all Festival days and all Festival hours. Artists are allowed to have helpers assist in selling work, but it is important to our visitors that they be able to meet artists personally.
- Previous attendance is not a guarantee of acceptance into the 2010 Festival. No booth spaces will be saved for anyone for any reason.
- Exhibitors agree to allow the Tubac Chamber of Commerce to use their digital images and application materials for promotional purposes.

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## How To Apply

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- Applicants must properly complete and sign the 2010 Tubac Festival of the Arts application form. Photo copies of the application are acceptable. The application form is available on our website: [www.tubacaz.com](http://www.tubacaz.com).
- **Artists** are required to submit four (4) digital images representative of the work to be exhibited at the Festival, plus one (1) digital image showing your booth display. Please include a brief description of your work and the process by which it was created on the application.

- **Digital image requirements:** Images must be submitted on a PC-formatted CD labeled with artist's name and medium category. Image files must be in JPEG format, at least 72 dpi resolution, and no larger than 2 MB file size.
- **Food vendors** are required to submit a menu with prices and one (1) printed photo of your booth.
- A check including the \$25 application fee and appropriate booth and electricity fees must be sent with your application. Applications received without a check for the full amount will not be considered.
- Additional brochures or biographical information can be included with your application.
- Applicants agree to read and to abide by the Festival Rules listed on back of the application.
- Include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for jury notification.

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## Village Hospitality

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The Tubac Chamber of Commerce, our volunteers, Village merchants and residents work together to create a helpful and pleasant environment for our guest artists and vendors. Information on the amenities of the Tubac area are provided in check-in packets. The Tubac Chamber of Commerce runs an aggressive advertising campaign to promote the Festival of the Arts which is our biggest event of the year. A Festival program with a map showing booth locations and a list of exhibitors is provided.

Festival booths are located throughout the historic Village, mixed in with more than 100 galleries, shops and working artist studios. Horse-drawn trolleys, roving street performers and a food court enhance the festival atmosphere.

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## Important Information

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- **Festival Dates:** February 10 - February 14, 2010 (Wednesday through Sunday)
- **Festival Hours:** 10am to 5pm every day
- **Application deadline:** October 30, 2009
- **Jury notification:** Notifications will be mailed by November 20, 2009.
- **Cancellation deadline:** Booth fees are refundable if the Tubac Chamber of Commerce office is notified in writing of your withdrawal by December 4, 2009. Cancellations after December 4, 2009 will result in forfeiture of booth fees.
- **Check-in:** Exhibitors must check-in and setup for the Festival during the afternoon of Tuesday, February 9, 2010. Time and location will be announced at a later date. Photo ID will be required at check-in.

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## Booth Space and Fees

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- The Festival is held outdoors. Booth spaces are located along the streets in the historic district of Tubac Village. There are no refunds, rain checks or extended show dates due to inclement weather.
- Booth spaces cannot be shared. Only one artist/food vendor per booth space.
- Booth spaces are assigned by the Tubac Chamber of Commerce. All merchandise and equipment must be kept within the assigned space.
- Exhibitors display all merchandise and equipment at their own risk.
- All Artists must have a white tent.

■ Exhibitors are required to supply their own tents, tables, chairs and display equipment. The Tubac Chamber of Commerce does not provide any equipment or supplies.

■ **Artist & Packaged Product Booths:** Include a check for \$25 non-refundable application fee and \$575 booth space fee (10' x 10') with application. A limited number of double booth spaces are available (20' wide x 10' deep) for a \$1150 fee.

■ **Food Booths:** Include a check for \$25 non-refundable application fee and \$900 booth space fee with application. Food booths are 10' x 15'. Additional space is \$50 per foot. Electricity is available in the food court for an additional fee (see application). Please include electricity fee and extra space fee in check.

■ **Make check or money order payable to: Tubac Chamber of Commerce.** Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Do not postdate checks.

■ **Commission:** There are NO commission fees.

■ **Parking:** No parking on streets during Festival hours. Free vendor parking in designated lots.

■ **Sales Tax:** All participants are required to charge and to pay Arizona and Santa Cruz County sales taxes (there is no city sales tax). The sales tax rate is 6.6%. Please download the "Transaction Privilege Tax Application - Short Form" from the Arizona Department of Revenue website at [www.azdor.gov](http://www.azdor.gov). The tax license fee is \$12.

■ **Health Permits:** Food vendors are required to have a temporary food permit from the Santa Cruz County health department, (520) 375-7900. The permit fee is currently \$75.
